

BLESSED TRINITY SCHOOL'S AMENDMENT TO THE ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY PICTURE USAGE

Our Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) does not include permission to have your child's picture posted on the Internet. This document serves as an Amendment to our existing AUP and, when signed by you, gives Blessed Trinity School (BTS) permission to post your child's picture (without any names identifying individual children) on the Internet. BTS has chosen to keep this Amendment separate because this covers a different aspect of Internet use entirely.

Each classroom teacher has an individual Web Page posted on the Internet. Some teachers are interested in posting class pictures of important educational activities on their Web Page. These pictures will be posted without identifying or calling attention to any individual student in keeping with BTS' Internet safety policy.
