- Olivia and the Rain Dance, by Maggie Testa (level 1.4)

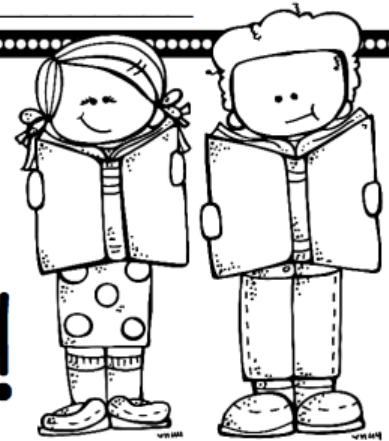
Students may choose a book from the list above based on their reading level and create a book jacket for the book. A sample of the book jacket is on the next page.
