Practicing grade level math work is essential to enforcing student understanding and improving student efficiency with math concepts.

Consistently engaging in math practice throughout the summer keeps the brain thinking and helps to minimize learning loss. This also ensures that the students are prepared when math lessons start up again and the work provides the teacher with important data used to guide instruction.

Summer math assignment beginning the week of June 16th:

50 minutes of IXL recommended math skills practice per week

- Students are to use their IXL login information from the 2024–2025 school year.
- Students may work in the Diagnostic arena before 3PM until their current levels are assessed.
- Students should then focus on the skills that have been recommended either by Mr. Herrera or from the Diagnostic on www.ixl.com
- The 50 minutes may be split up however the student wants throughout the week, so long as the total amount of time spent on math practice adds up to 50 minutes by the end of the week.
