Students will choose a book that is within their Lexile reading range (refer to iReady diagnostic). As they read, they will complete the reading comprehension questions for that book.

Remember, strong readers stop and think about what they are reading. These comprehension questions are designed to help students stay engaged with the story, reflect on important events, and think deeply about the characters and lessons in the book.

As students read:

- ✓ Pause after each chapter or reading section.
- ✓ Read the questions.
- ✓ Refer back to the text for evidence.
- ✓ Answer in complete sentences.
- ✓ Support your thinking with details from the story.
